### **The On call intervention worker position:**

Excellent opportunity for students studying psychology, sociology, social work, community services, etc.

This is an excellent opportunity to work with a vulnerable population in a dynamic organization in the community. You will learn about issues related to homelessness, domestic violence and mental health and be able to actively participate in telephone inquiries and general management of the shelter.

Logifem provides its staff with the opportunity to do inspiring work in a professional, ethical and multicultural environment. We are looking for people who share our vision of being a transformative force in the lives of women in need and who have the skills and training to play that role. Every member of the team is important to us.

### **On call shift requirements:**

As an on-call worker we guarantee at least one shift each week for a minimum of 5 hours. Each on-call worker must be able to offer at least two evening shifts and at least two night shifts each week.

### **Main tasks:**

- Ensure a significant presence, daily contact and psychological support for the residents at all times
- Ensure the smooth running of the house by following the pre-established routine (medications, meals, rounds, residents' tasks during the week, etc.)
- Review the logbook, progress notes, reports, resident files and record relevant information as required
- Ensure the well-being and safety of the residents at all times
- Participate in weekly team meetings, as required
- Intervene in crisis situations
- Participate in the preparation and serving of meals
- Perform housekeeping duties during night shifts

### **Qualifications:**

- College degree in a social service related discipline
- Minimum of one year experience in a community setting
- Excellent organizational and administrative skills
- Autonomous, resourceful and adaptable
- Problem solving skills
- Ability to manage stress in a crisis situation
- Fluency in French and English (written and spoken)
- Very good knowledge of MS Office
- First Aid and CPR training an asset
